Introduction

Rapid development of cross-border trade within European Union determines the need for well trained professionals with solid international legal background. Today, in order to successfully operate international business commercial subjects must not only know their rights and duties under the supranational (EU) law but also understand the way EU law reflects in the national legal systems and comprehend the various commercial aspects of legal environment in different countries. Therefore, a lawyer with European business law knowledge will easily find his way both in private entities (as in-house counsels, attorneys or other kind of advisors) and public sectors (as a judge, notary, or take other position dealing with the commercial EU law).

About the programme

European business law is master degree programme which primarily has a purpose to broaden and deepen student's knowledge gained during the first level (bachelor) studies. The main aims of the programme are:

- to provide the students with necessary European business law theoretical and practical knowledge and to acquaint them with the most recent tendencies in the European business area;
- to teach the students to apply the gained theoretical knowledge in practice while analysing different factual situations related to starting and developing business in the EU internal market, concluding international commercial transactions, dealing with corporate governance, competition, investment, financial, intellectual property, consumer protection, civil liability, international carriage of goods, dispute settlement and other issues;
- to educate the students to be able to identify particular factual problems and to determine the solutions of these problems;
- to develop the students' ability to critically analyse, summarize and evaluate the theoretical and empirical study materials etc.
