

RULES FOR ADMISSION OF COLLEGE GRADUATES IN BRIDGE STUDIES

Bridge studies are aimed at Graduates of colleges who have a professional Bachelor's degree. Applicants with a college bachelor's degree from an accredited social work programme and one year work experience in social work field or with an average of at least 8 grades of professional bachelor's and no less than 8 for final thesis can apply for admission without bridge studies.

Those who do not meet the above mentioned requirements have to take bridge studies:
