


Instructions for signing a Master's thesis Licence Agreement

Master's students of Mykolas Romeris University sign a Master's thesis Licence Agreement in the MRU Information System for Students: https://stdb.mruni.eu/menu_stud_en.php

1. Log in 'My studies' with your MRU credentials and select 'Master's Degree Thesis' in the menu:



2. In the open window the following data will appear: 1. Master's thesis access terms and in case of access restriction 2. Embargo expiration date:
