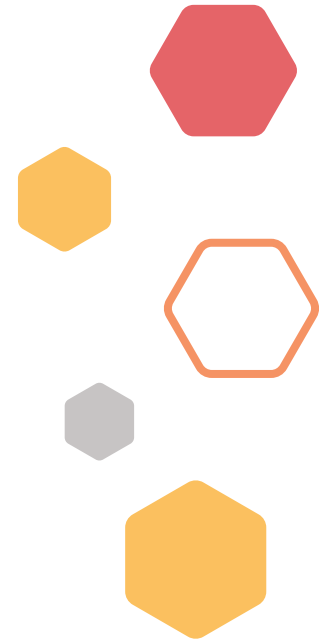




Functionality

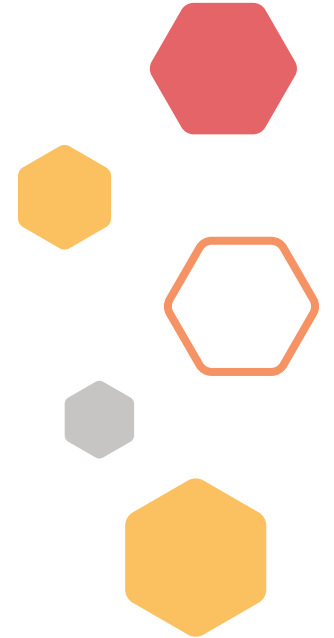

- A free, open-source research tool that helps you collect, organize, and analyze research and share it in a variety of ways
- Easy to create an account
- Software installation is simple
- Very efficient for saving entries from various sources
- Tagging of the saved entries for the easier search later
- Possibility to collaborate and share a Library
- Free 300 MB of a storage amount (expiration – NEVER)
- There are paid options for the storage too



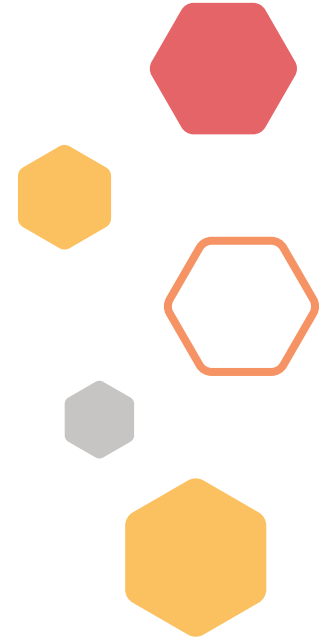

- There are paid options for the storage too

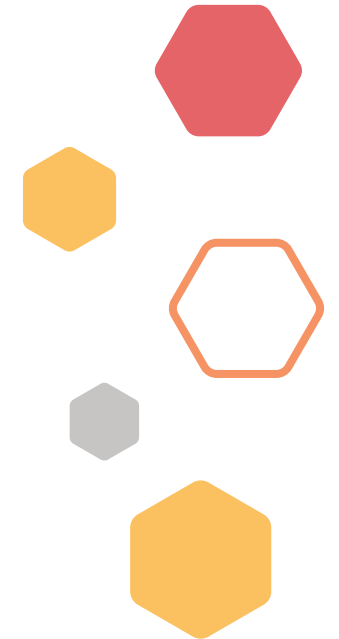

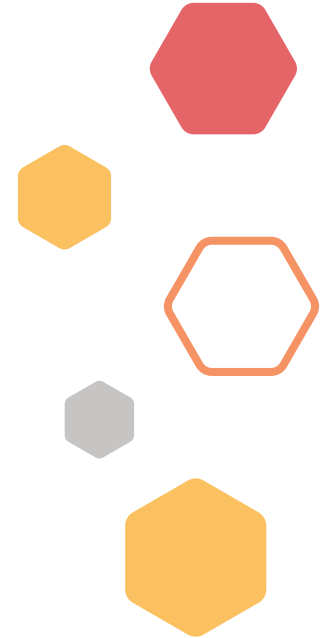

Zotero is open source and developed by an independent, nonprofit organization that has no financial interest in your private information. With Zotero, you always stay in control of your own data.

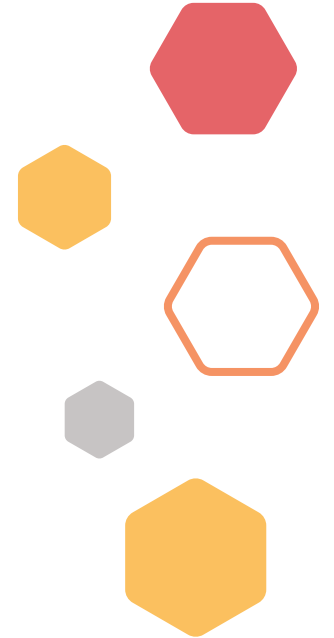

ZOTERO: Creating an account

- www.zotero.org
- Click "Log In"
- Click "Register for a free account"
- You will need to:
 - Enter: User name and Email
 - Confirm: Email
 - Create and enter: Password
 - Verify: Password
 - Click the box: I'm not a robot

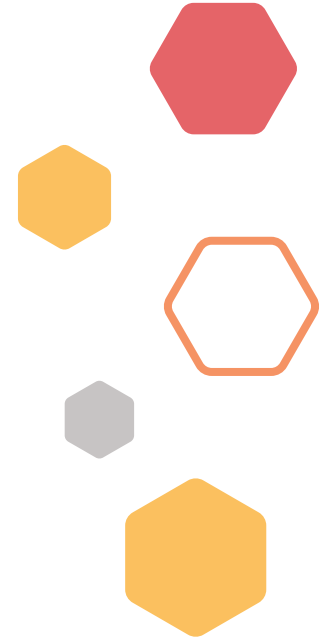

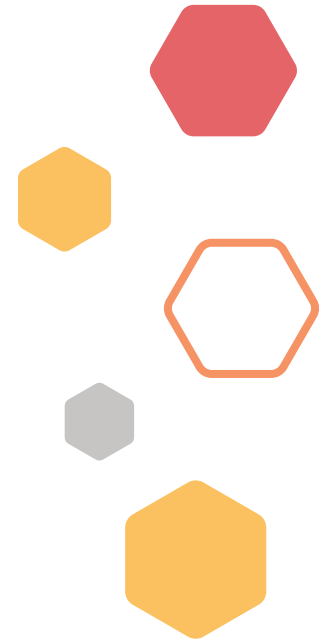

Zotero is the only software that automatically senses research on the web. Need an article from JSTOR or a preprint from arXiv.org? A news story from the New York Times or a book from a library? Zotero has you covered, everywhere.

ZOTERO: Organizing materials

Zotero helps you organize your research any way you want. You can sort items into collections, create new collections and subcollections, tag saved items with keywords and easily find them later.

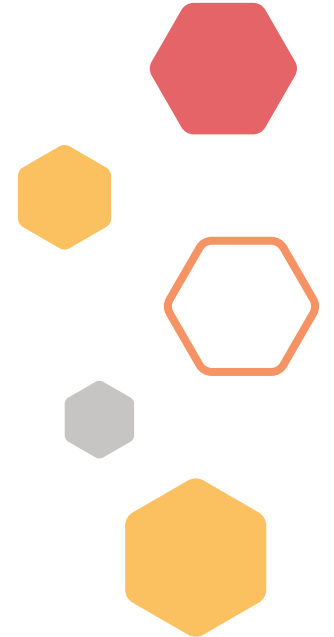
ZOTERO: Data synchronization

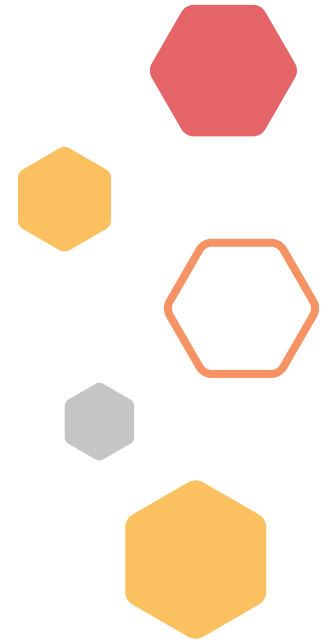
