



## CALL FOR SOON TO BE GRADUATES

Erasmus+ traineeship (work placements, internships etc) abroad is open to recent graduates.

## TIME OF TRAINEESHIP:

Traineeship can last between 2 - 3 months respecting the regarding permission to travel from Lithuania to other Schengen countries - up to 90 days within 180-day period. Selected Recent graduates may start traineeship within 10 months after they receive their diploma. Leaving minimum months implementation of traineeship. Traineeship cannot start/end on weekends or national holidays.

Erasmus+ Traineeship adds a great value to your future carrier.

# ERASMUS+ FOR RECENT GRADUATES

If you are International Fulltime Student

- √ who is graduating from Mykolas Romeris University;
- ✓ who has Temporary Residence Permit valid for additional period after graduation (usually for 9 or 12 months for the purpose of finding employment in Lithuania);
- ✓ who have not used more than 10 months of "Erasmus" mobility (study/traineeship) period during the same cycle of studies:
- ✓ who have found a suitable organization for traineeship (or, as a last resort, have not yet received approval from an accepting organization);
- you can apply for Erasmus+ traineeship grant for recent graduates.

#### **Apply before graduation!**

Students who successfully defended their final paper/theses and are foreseeing graduation from their studies this semester must apply for Erasmus+ mobility grant for recent graduates 7 working days before receiving their diploma.

\*\*\* After graduation call is closed and it will no longer be possible to participate and/or be selected.
