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# CURONIAN SPIT

## Danės g. 1, Klaipėda (Ferry)

The Curonian Spit is a sand dune peninsula, stretching to 98km in length and 0.4-4km in width. It is consistently maintained by relentless human intervention, lest it should be eroded by natural phenomena.

You will be able to take a ferry ride to separate strips of land and explore breathtaking views of the Baltic Sea. See our Nida guide to find out more.

## Left bank of the Danė River


The ship "Meridianas" allows you to have the full dining experience while sailing through the port of Klaipėda.


## SCULPTURE PARK

Klaipėda's sculpture park houses a total of 116 modern sculptures created by 61 Lithuanian artists between the years of 1977 - 1991.

The park is located only 20 minutes walk away from the city center and is the perfect place for an atmospheric walk.




## Monai
