
Opportunity to all (BA, MA or PhD International Full-time Students at Mykolas Romeris University!

If you have successfully defended your final thesis, passed all exams, and are on the verge of graduation, this is an exciting opportunity for you. Those with a Temporary Residence Permit or, for EU citizens, a Certificate of Temporary Residence in Lithuania (allowing an additional period of 9 or 12 months for employment search) are eligible to **apply for the Erasmus+ traineeship grant for recent graduates**.

To avail of this opportunity, **students must apply before officially graduating from the University**. Please note that applications will not be accepted after graduation.

Ensure you **submit your application before the deadline on January 24th at 23:59**. Don't miss out on this chance to kickstart your post-graduate journey!

*Graduates can plan to undertake their traineeship within a minimum period of 10 months from the day of graduation, allowing at least 2 months (60 days) for the internship itself.

* The duration of the Erasmus+ traineeship for recent graduates' ranges from 2 to 3 months, or 4 months if a visa of accepting Country is obtained.

*The departure for the Erasmus+ traineeship for recent graduates is formalized in the same way as for a currently studying student.
