TRANSPORTATION IN VILNIUS

Public Transport:
Well-developed system with buses & trolleybuses.
Ticket options: 30 min, 60 min, 1/3/12 days, 1/3/12 months.

Purchase via Trafi or m.Ticket apps. Timetables & routes: judu.lt

Taxis & Ride Apps:

Taxis are affordable (0.65–0.95 €/km).

Ride apps: Bolt, Uber, A2B Taxi (to avoid overcharging).

From the Airport:

By bus: 3G → "Žaliasis tiltas" → No. 10 → "Mykolo

Romerio universitetas" (~50 min).

By taxi: ~20 €. Use Bolt/Uber/A2B Taxi.

Students can open bank accounts but must close them before leaving.



• HEALTH INSURANCE FOR FOREIGNERS IN LITHUANIA

Mandatory for your entire stay (Schengen area coverage).


- Minimum coverage: €30,000, including emergency care & repatriation.
 - **EU citizens: Bring European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).**
- Non-EU citizens: Get insurance before arrival or ask the International Office for guidance.
- **V** Local insurance: Costs ~€87–115 for 5 months.
 - Medical visits: Pay upfront & claim reimbursement from your insurer.
