TEEP was launched in 2015 by the Taiwan Ministry of Education (MOE). Every TEEP affiliated university program in Taiwan submits an annual budget and planning proposal for MOE review and approval. All programs must comply with government regulations to ensure the basic rights of international students and education quality.

Internship

TEEP participants will be placed in a laboratory, and provided with opportunities to attend seminars to enhance their professional capabilities.

Scholarship Grants

To help students meet living expenses, We offer eligible TEEP participants a **\$12,000** monthly (up to 4 months) stipend

(participants will be responsible for covering their travel expenses, including flight tickets, living costs, and accommodation fees)

The actual stipend amount is determined by each program director.

Duration : 4 months (2026/Feb.-2026/June.)

Vacancy : Maximum 2 students per program
